Main Storylines of the Episode:

- Jacob's well, the Samaritan woman, and Jesus' revealing of truth and spirit!
- Jesus leading the disciples in a change of direction from what they were expecting

What surprised you and captured your attention most about this episode?

And the question for the disciples and us:

- How hard is it to make a course change with and without Jesus?
- And what new thing are you afraid Jesus might lead you to?

For reflection and study on your own---

John 4:1-42 The story of the woman at the well and Jesus

Are we by nature wary of new things?

- Familiarity is comfortable and predictable
- Change brings the unknown—can be scary, strange, uncomfortable, unpredictable
- What are some examples in your life?

It is important to remember what God has done for His chosen people—Isaiah 43:16-17,19

- who in the Old Testament did God empower to do impossible things? Genesis 12:1-3; Genesis 46:2-4; Exodus 33:12-17; 1 Samuel 17:20-49.
- who in the New Testament? Matthew 10; Luke 10:1-24; Book of Acts

But God also tells us to not stay in the past! Isaiah 43:18-19; Jeremiah 16:14-15; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Ephesians 4:23-24

Jesus is our Waymaker! He doesn't ask us to make our own way. He asks us to allow Him to lead and equip and provide. Read 1 Corinthians 1: 26-31. Like His trip through Samaria, He is doing new things and through us, building His kingdom and accomplishing His good and perfect will—from the beginning of time to the end!
